Hand out to each student a copy of page one, a pencil and a Bible, preferably an ESV (English Standard Version) which is a near word-for-word translation and is easier to understand than a King James Version. **Pray** for God to bring everyone all wisdom, then ask **What do these verses say about God's Word, His very personal, private promises? Fill-in the blanks in teams of two or three.**

A. Psalm 25:14 "The **friendship** [or *The secret counsel*] of the LORD is for those who fear Him, and **He** makes known to them His covenant."

He reveals to His followers hidden, personal (for you only) promises & commands through His written Word if you will ask and read. His Word is the best plan for you in each moment. He speaks it into your spirit and often confirms it through other mature followers and other verses in Scripture.

B. Psalm 27:13-14 "I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living! Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!"

C. Isaiah 33:6 "and He will be the **stability** of your times, **abundance of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge**; the fear of the LORD is Zion's [Hebrew "His"] treasure."

He holds you and sustains you, so breathe in some faith and trust Him to give you plenty of wisdom.

D. Zephaniah 3:17 "The LORD your God is in Your midst, a mighty one who will **save**; He will rejoice over you with gladness; He will **quiet you** by His Love; He will **exult over you** with loud singing."

Yes, with His Love He saves you and He dances and sings over you loudly in heaven while angels watch and work. With His Love He calms you in stormy places and heals your body, soul and spirit.

E. Romans 8:35-37 "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall **tribulation**, or distress, or **persecution**, or **famine**, or **nakedness**, or danger, or **sword**? As it is written "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

Through Jesus you are able to conquer your temptations and lead others to salvation.

F. Galatians 5:1 "For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and **do not submit again** to a yoke of **slavery**."

Fall into sin easily? His Love doesn't leave you. So, ask Him for strength and walk away from activities, people and places that pull you until you have conquered your temptations.

Take 60 seconds for students to go to a quiet corner to answer the following alone:

Do I trust Him? **Circle one:** Yes No Do I believe what His Word says? **Circle one:** Yes No
Have I experienced His love? **Circle one:** Yes No Have I taken His offer of salvation? **Circle one:** Yes No

I may not have observed His goodness even though He is good to me. He always gives me new chances to trust Him and experience His goodness (His Love - not as the world gives, true freedom, calm during terrible situations, wisdom for choices, and power to be more than a conquerer).

Have a student reread outloud the highlighted words. Discuss "I think God's Word (His written promises) is/isn't trustworthy", and "He does _____ for those who exercise or practice trust in Him (believe Him, have faith in Him)". **Pray:** ask for forgiveness, more faith, and time with God this week. **Ask** if anyone is ready to accept what Jesus accomplished on the cross for their sins, then pray asking the Holy Spirit to come in, conquer their sin, make Jesus be Savior and Lord of their life, and turn them each morning into a new creation in the Messiah with power to follow God's Word and reach out to others.
